In 14 exhibition halls of the Karaganda Regional Museum of local lore with an area of 1,800 sq.m., the guide not only visited all the halls, but also explained their significance. Among them are the nature, ancient history, life and culture of the population of Karaganda region. The museum's funds contain more than 133 thousand exhibits. They clearly reflect the historical periods of this region.

The museum has five departments: nature, general and modern history, public excursion and Conservation Fund. Objects of archeology, ethnography, and Applied Arts can reveal the culture and customs of the Kazakh, Russian, Ukrainian, and Korean peoples living in this region.





In 2017, the Karaganda Regional Museum of local lore celebrated its 85th anniversary.

In the large hall at the entrance to the museum, a physical and geographical map of the Karaganda region is shown, which provides general information about the territory, population, and population of the region. Karaganda region is located in a favorable geographical position at the junction of Europe and Asia, the total area of the region is 428.0 thousand square kilometers.
