

Report on visiting the Museum of memory of victims of political repression (KarLag) in the village of Dolinka

On April 14, 2020, students of the OP-18-2 and OP-18-2C groups visited the Museum of memory of victims of political repression (KarLag) in the village of Dolinka with the curator of the group Adilova N. D. at the expense of the VKS.

In 1931, the state farm "Giant" with an area of 17 thousand hectares was organized in the Kazakh steppe. Under this name appeared an institution that from 1931 to 1959 forever distorted the fate of 6 million political prisoners, internees and prisoners of war. His name is Karlag NKVD. The total area of the camp is comparable in size to the territory of France. Kazakhs, Germans, Russians, Romanians, Hungarians, poles, Belarusians, Jews, Chechens, Ingush, French, Georgians, Italians, Kirghiz, Ukrainians, Japanese, Finns, Lithuanians, Latvians, Estonians — the infernal millstones of the NKVD crushed everyone, without considering their nationalities.







Tasks:
