

Master class on "Traditions and customs of the Kazakh people"

On March 16, 2022, the teacher of the department "Kazakh language and culture" Kuleimenova L.M. in a remote format, a master class was held, in the supervised group TT-21-1, on the topic "Traditions and customs of the Kazakh people".
