### Report on the results of the survey

#### «Master students' satisfaction with educational services»

In February 2025, the Center for quality management and accreditation conducted an anonymous electronic survey "Master students' satisfaction with educational services".

**The purpose of the survey** was to measure consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the university.

The subject of the survey was the formed ideas of master's students about the organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the survey were processed and presented in a generalized form with a guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of master's students.

**The object of the survey** was the 1 and 2 year master students.


30 respondents took part in the survey, which amounted to 85.8% of the total number of master students.







#### Conclusions on the results of the survey:

- 1. The main factors determining the choice of studying in a Master's program at a university:
  - continuing education at the same university (58.5%);
  - prestige of the university (33.5%);
  - high quality of education (28.4%);
  - proximity to the family's place of residence (27.8%);
  - acceptable cost of education (26.2%);
  - the ability to easily find a job with a diploma from this university (21.6%);
  - leading scientists among the faculty (15.4%).
  - 2. Satisfaction with the availability of information:
  - Average level of satisfaction: 92.5%;
- Meaning: a high level of satisfaction indicates the availability and satisfactory nature of the information, which helps master students effectively plan their educational activities.
- 3. Assessment of the teaching staff: more than 92% of master students rated the level of knowledge, professionalism, objectivity, pedagogical skills and methods of the teachers as "very high" and "high".
- 4. Participation of the master's degree student in the development of an individual work plan:
- 55.1% of master's degree students actively participate in the development of their work plan under the supervision of their supervisor, which indicates the independence and responsibility of the master's degree students;
- 9.1% of master's degree students develop a plan independently, and the supervisor signs it without exerting significant influence;
- 18.7% of master's degree students see their participation as formal, since they relied more on the help of the supervisor due to difficulties in independently formulating ideas;
- 4.5% of master students do not participate at all, however, self-critically assessing their efforts, they believe that they could not have coped without the main assistance of their supervisor;
- 12.5% of master students find it difficult to answer whose initiative was greater: theirs or their supervisor's.

- 5. Satisfaction with the supervisor's assistance in preparing their master's thesis: 93.7% of master's students are completely satisfied with the assistance provided by their supervisor. This indicator indicates a high level of satisfaction among master's students with the quality and support they receive from their supervisor.
  - 6. Indicators of a high scientific level of the university:
- a modern material and technical base (69.9%) has a great impact on the quality of scientific research and on the training of master's students;
- a strong teaching staff (65.4%) contributes to high-quality educational and scientific activities;
- the involvement of master's students in research projects (56.8%) indicates active scientific activity of master's students;
- participation in international research projects (34.1%) provides them with the opportunity to work with advanced technologies and methods;
- participation of the university in the development of target programs for socio-economic development (31.3%) indicates its significant role in the socio-economic development of society.
- work of famous foreign scientists at the university (13%) contributes to the exchange of experience, development of scientific ties and attraction of international projects;
- 7. Participation of master's students in research projects and scientific life of the university: 78.9% of master's students actively participate in research projects and attend scientific events, such as seminars and conferences. These data show that most master's students are involved in scientific activities, which contributes to their academic and professional development.
- 8. Publication of scientific papers: over the entire period of their activity, 81.3% of master's students published their theses and articles in both Kazakhstan and foreign publications. This indicates a high degree of involvement of master's degree students in the scientific community and their desire to disseminate the results of their research at the international level.
- 9. The level of foreign language proficiency among master's degree students varies significantly: 100% of some master's degree students speak and understand a foreign language fluently, while others are only at the initial stage of learning it and need constant reference to a dictionary or help from a teacher.
  - 10. Participation of master's degree students in the work of the department:
- research work of the department (design, experimental design, technological, etc.) as a full participant: 68.2%;
  - writing scientific articles: 85.3%;
  - participation with reports at conferences and seminars: 74.5%;
  - preparation of reports on research, abstracts: 93.7%.
- 11. Satisfaction of master students with the scientific and educational environment of the University:
- Organization of conferences, round tables, forums at the University, with the participation of master students: 91.5%.
  - Material and technical support for applied scientific research: 93.7%.

- Availability of equipment, computers necessary for the educational process and scientific activity: 91.5%.
  - General level of organization and implementation of foreign internships: 85.3%.
- Availability of library collections, electronic databases and Internet resources: 93.7%.
  - Availability of scientific equipment, tools, materials: 87.5%.
  - Availability of laboratories, specialized facilities and experimental sites: 87.5%.
  - 12. Organization of the educational process:
  - Organization of the educational process and industrial practice: 93.7%.
  - Organization of free time: 85.2%.
  - Organization of meals: 100%.
  - Living conditions in the hostel: 69.9%.

Overall, master students highly value the research and learning opportunities provided by the university, which is reflected in postgraduate satisfaction.

The overall satisfaction of master students in the Information Systems major with educational services is **88%**, indicating a high level of student satisfaction overall, despite individual problems and areas for improvement.
