In February 2025, the center for quality management and accreditation conducted an anonymous electronic questionnaire **«Satisfaction of master's students with educational services»**

The aim of the study is measuring consumer satisfaction with the quality of services provided by the university.

Subject of research: the formed ideas of master's students about the organization of the educational process, the degree of satisfaction with its various characteristics.

The results of the questionnaire were processed and presented in a generalized form with a guarantee of confidentiality of the personal opinions of the master's students.

Object research - 1st-2nd year master's students.


47 respondents took part in the questionnaire, which constituted 78.4% of the total number of master's students.






























13.3 Organization of free time



Please write down what questions you think should be added to this questionnaire in order to improve the curriculum, improve the quality of services provided and other areas of activity of the university (The answers of the students are presented in the original. The author's spelling and punctuation are preserved):

- I am experiencing difficulties with the lack of a laboratory to conduct research related to the testing of building structures.

- many undergraduates are already adult working people, the university does not take this into account when scheduling couples. (one couple in the middle of the day is not convenient!)

Conclusions based on the questionnaire results:

The main factors determining the choice of studying in a Master's degree program at a university:

- continuation of education at the same university (65.6%);
- availability of budget places (59.6%);
- proximity to the family's place of residence (38.4%);
- high quality of education (29.7%);
- the opportunity to complete internships abroad during studies (21.5%);
- affordable tuition fees (8.5%);
- the opportunity to engage in science while studying (6.5%).

Additional factors: the prestige of the university, the ability to easily find a job with a diploma from this university and a wide choice of specialties also influence the choice of a master's degree.

Satisfaction with the availability of information:

- Average satisfaction level: (96.2%).
- Meaning: A high level of satisfaction indicates that information is accessible and satisfactory, which helps students plan their learning activities effectively.

Evaluation of the teaching staff of the master's program:

- more than 79.7% of students rated the level of knowledge, professionalism, objectivity, teaching skills and methods of teachers as «very high» and «high».

Participation of master's students in the formation of an individual work plan:

- 76.9% of master's students actively participate in developing their work plan under the supervision of their supervisor, which indicates the independence and responsibility of students;
- 8.5% of students form a plan independently, and the supervisor signs it without exerting significant influence;
- 2.1% of students see their participation as formal, as they relied more on the help of the supervisor due to difficulties in independently formulating ideas;
- 2.1% of students do not participate at all, however, self-critically assessing their efforts, they believe that they would not have been able to cope without the main help of their academic supervisor;
- 10.4% of students find it difficult to answer whose initiative was greater theirs or their supervisor's.

Satisfaction with the assistance of the scientific supervisor:

- Satisfaction level: 95.8%
- Significance: high level of satisfaction of master's students with the quality of support from their academic supervisor.

Indicators of the high scientific level of the University:

- 1. Modern material and technical base: 72.3%;
- 2. Strong teaching staff: 61.5%;
- 3. Involvement in research projects: 51.2%;
- 4. Availability of publications of university staff in international publications: 31.8%;

- 5. Participation in international research projects: 29.9%;
- 6. Participation in targeted programs of socio-economic development: 25.5%;
- 7. Work of famous foreign scientists: 12.9%;
- 8. Awards, prizes for achievements in science: 10.6%.

Publication of scientific papers:

- Active participation: 49.2% of master's students
- Meaning: the degree of involvement in the scientific community and the desire to disseminate research results is average.

The analysis revealed that 66.5% of master's students published scientific articles in Kazakhstani and foreign publications during their educational activities. This indicator indicates a high degree of involvement of master's students in scientific research activities.

Level of foreign language proficiency:

- Different levels of proficiency: 95.7% of master's students
- Meaning: knowledge of a foreign language from a basic level to complete freedom in expression, while some do not know the language at all, which can create difficulties in learning and communication.

Participation of graduate students in the work of the department:

- research work of the department (design, experimental design, technological, etc.) as a full participant: 72.3%.
 - writing scientific articles: 87.2%.
 - participation with reports at conferences and seminars: 76.7%.
 - preparation of research reports, abstracts: 82.9%.

Satisfaction of master's students with the scientific and educational environment of the university:

- Organization of conferences, round tables, forums at the university, with the participation of master's students: 87.2%.
 - Material and technical support for applied scientific research: 85%.
- Availability of technology and computers necessary for the educational process and scientific activities: 87.3%.
 - Overall level of organization and implementation of foreign internships: 82.9%.
- Availability of library collections, electronic databases and Internet resources: 91.4%.
 - Availability of scientific equipment, instruments, materials: 78.6%.
 - Availability of laboratories, specialized facilities and experimental sites: 76.6%.

Students' satisfaction with the quality of educational services:

- 1. Organization of the educational process: 93.7%;
- 2. Living conditions in a hostel: 61.8%;
- 3. Organization of free time: 89.4%;4. Organization of food: 76.7%;
- 5. Organization of industrial practice: 91.6%.

Overall rating:

- Postgraduates highly value research and teaching opportunities, which is reflected in overall satisfaction with the university's services and support.

Final satisfaction of master's degree students in the specialty «Construction» educational services is **81,7%**, which indicates a high level of satisfaction among students in general, despite individual problems and areas for improvement.

Recommendations:
