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REGULATIONS of the student club

1. Mission and strategy

1. Mission of the Sanaly Urpak Project for 2018–2020 (hereinafter referred to as the Project): patriotic and competitive youth aimed at living in Kazakhstan, free from corruption.

2. The goal of the Project is to eradicate corruption in the education system, create an environment of general rejection of corruption through the education system.

3. The Project strategy is based on approbation and implementation of pilot areas in order to further use the best practices in educational institutions of the country.

2. General provisions

2.1 The sphere of education is a factor not only in the educational, but also in the spiritual and cultural development of modern youth. Academic honesty is one of the main factors in the quality of education and the formation of anti-corruption consciousness of students and allows us to highlight the key factors that contribute to the commission of corruption offenses, for the solution of which the main directions of the Project Office are determined:

- anti-corruption culture;
- transparency and openness of education at the university;
- academic integrity;
- anti-corruption legislation in the field of education;
- Information support.

2.2 The Student Club of Sanaly Urpak will be involved in the implementation of three areas of the Project Office:

- anti-corruption culture, the tasks of which are to increase the anti-corruption literacy of all subjects in the field of education, the cultivation of anti-corruption behavior among the subjects of the field of education, and the transformation of students and teachers into active participants in anti-corruption policy;
- academic honesty, the tasks of which are to form a university that does not accept the "selling of grades", to encourage teachers to apply anti-corruption mechanisms in practice, to increase the cult of knowledge among students;
- information support, the tasks of which are information support of the student club, providing effective "feedback" through the media, social networks, maximum involvement of citizens, experts, public figures, etc. in the Sanaly Urpak Student Club.

2.3. The Student Club of Sanaly Urpak is a voluntary association of students to achieve the goals and objectives provided for by this Regulation.

2.4. In its activities, the Student Club of Sanaly urpak is guided by the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the regulatory legal acts of the Republic of Kazakhstan, and the statutory documents of the Project Office "Sanaly urpak".

3. Aims, tasks, and functions of the Community

3.1 The purpose of organizing a student club is to create conditions at the university for the formation and development of a highly moral, responsible, enterprising, and socially competent citizen and patriot of his country.

3.2 The main tasks of the student club are:

- implementation of measures aimed at spiritual and moral and civic-patriotic education;
- formation of political and legal knowledge among students;
- formation of anti-corruption consciousness and anti-corruption culture among students;
- Encouraging initiatives to strengthen zero tolerance for corruption;
- participation in the organization of anti-corruption events.

3.3 The implementation of the tasks of the Student Club Sanaly Urpak is carried out by forming sections in the following areas:

- anti-corruption knowledge;
- anti-corruption information and creativity;
- cultural events.

3.4. Expected results:

- implementation of measures aimed at spiritual, moral, and civil-patriotic education;
- strengthening students' confidence in public authorities;
- formation of political and legal knowledge among students;
- formation of moral and ethical value bases of anti-corruption behavior among students.

The following types of education are used to carry out a set of activities:

- spiritual and moral education is aimed at the formation of moral and ethical attitudes, the formation of zero tolerance for corruption in each student;
- social and legal education is aimed at getting an idea of the essence of the relationship between a citizen and the state, knowledge about rights and obligations, persuasion of the need to comply with legal norms, awareness of the public danger of corruption;
- aesthetic education is aimed at developing students' understanding of the beauty of works of art, and literature, contributing to the education of students of aesthetic taste, and a benevolent and patriotic attitude towards the surrounding reality.

4. Organization of the activities of the student community "Sanaly urpaq"

4.1 The plan of the club is approved by the head of the department of the ANK and SHD.

4.2 The management of the club was carried out by teachers of the ANK and SHD Seydinova M.A., Zhumatova G.M.

4.3 The chairmanship of the club is assigned to the student of the group ND-20-2, Savriev M.S. (mobile: 8-707 241 76 59)

4.4 The club includes students of KarTU named after Abylkas Saginov.

4.5 The organizational basis of educational work is:
