ADMISSION RULES FOR STUDIES at Abylkas Saginov Karaganda Technical University

General provisions

Admission Rules for Studies at Abylkas Saginov Karaganda Technical University NJSC (hereinafter referred to as the Admission Rules) have been developed in accordance with subparagraph 6) of paragraph 2), Article 43-1 "Activities and Competence of Organizations of Higher and (or) Postgraduate Education" of the Republic of Kazakhstan Law dated July 27, 2007 "On Education". Admission of persons entering Abylkas Saginov "Karaganda Technical University NJSC (hereinafter referred to as the University) for educational programs of higher and postgraduate education is performed through the placement of an educational grant for higher and postgraduate education at the expense of the republican and local budget, as well as payment for tuition at the expense of citizens' own funds and the other sources. Amendments to the Admission Rules are made based on the results of monitoring and analyzing formation of the student contingent and (or) in the event of amendments to the regulatory legal acts (hereinafter referred to as RLA) of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

4. On approval of the Model Rules for admission to study at education organizations implementing educational programs of higher and postgraduate education. Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 31, 2018 No. 600.
5. On approval of the Model Rules for the activities of higher and (or) postgraduate education organizations. Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595.

2. Procedure for admission

The University admits persons with general secondary, technical and vocational, post-secondary, higher education.

By the decision of Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU or a person acting in his/her stead, the Admissions Committee is formed. The Admissions Committee consists of Chairman of the Board, Rector, vice-rectors, representatives of structural divisions and the faculty of the University. The Admissions Committee consists of an odd number, and Chairman of the Admissions Committee is elected by the majority of votes from among the members of the Committee. Chairman of the Admissions Committee is Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University or a person acting in his/her stead.

The Admissions Committee works from June 20 to August 25 of the calendar year.

Three days before the start of the admissions campaign, Responsible Secretary of the Admissions Committee of the University conducts a briefing with the detailed explanation of the functions of technical secretaries.

2.1 Bachelor's program

2.1.1 Admission of applicants to Abylkas Saginov KTU for higher education programs is performed through the placement of an educational grant at the expense of the republican budget and (or) the local budget, and (or) funds received from the republican budget within the framework of targeted transfers, as well as tuition fees from citizens' own funds and the other sources.

2.1.2 Applications received for higher education programs are accepted by the Admissions Committee of Abylkas Saginov KTU through the information system. The application deadline is from July 13 to July 20 of the calendar year.

2.1.3 The competition for an educational grant for higher education at the expense of the republican budget is held from August 21 to August 3 of the calendar year.

2.1.4 The competition for an educational grant for higher education at the expense of the local budget is held from August 5 to August 10 of the calendar year.

2.1.5 The competition for an educational grant for higher education at the expense of the Charitable Program "Educational Grants of the Public Fund "Kazakhstan Khalkyn" is held on the basis of the Rules determined by the Public Fund "Kazakhstan Khalkyn" in the period from August 1 to 17 of the calendar year (This clause was included by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

2.2 Bachelor's program. Full-time with a shortened period of training

2.2.1 Graduates of secondary, technical and vocational or post-secondary education institutions, with the exception of those entering related areas of higher education personnel training, have the right to enroll in the University for paid education upon scoring at least 50 points based on the UNT results, including at least 3 points in mathematics, reading literacy in the language of instruction, and at least 5 points in the history of Kazakhstan, and in each specialized subject, with the exception of those entering higher education programs requiring creative training. (This clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

Graduates of technical and vocational, post-secondary education organizations, entering the related areas of training, have the right to enroll in the University for fee-based education upon gaining at least 25 points based on the UNT results, including at least 5 points in a general discipline and at least 5 points in a specialized discipline.

Graduates of secondary, technical and vocational or post-secondary education organizations, entering higher education programs that require creative training, have the right to enroll in the University for fee-based education upon gaining at least 50 points based on the UNT results, including at least 5 points in the history of Kazakhstan and at least 3 points in reading literacy in the language of instruction, and at least 10 points for each creative exam (this paragraph was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

Graduates of technical and vocational, post-secondary education institutions, entering related areas of higher education personnel training that require creative training, have the right to enroll in Abylkas Saginov KTU for paid training, if they point at least 25 points based on the results of the UNT and creative exam, including at least 10 points for the creative exam and at least 5 points for the core discipline.

2.2.2 Graduates of secondary, technical and vocational or post-secondary education institutions, with the exception of those entering related areas of higher education personnel training, who have not pointed the threshold point based on the results of the UNT, can be enrolled in Abylkas Saginov KTU for full-time study on a paid basis until the completion of the first year.

2.2.3 Admission of persons with technical and vocational or post-secondary education with the qualification of "mid-level specialist" or "applied bachelor" in related areas of training higher education personnel, entering on a fee-paying basis, is carried out by the Admissions Committee of the University in the form of a written exam or an interview. Admission of persons with higher education entering on a fee-paying basis is performed by the Admissions Committee of the University in the form of an interview.

2.2.4 Admission of foreign citizens entering on a fee-paying basis is performed based on the results of an interview conducted by the Admissions offices of the University during the calendar year.

2.2.5 Admission of citizens with general secondary education, who have completed military service entering the University on a fee-paying basis is performed within two years after completing military service based on the results of an interview conducted by the Admissions offices of the University during the calendar year (this clause was supplemented by the decision of the Board of Directors of the Company dated July 31, 2023).

2.2.6 Citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan who have completed their compulsory military service and have technical and vocational, post-secondary or higher education are accepted within two years after completing their compulsory military service for training on a paid basis in higher education programs that provide for shortened periods of study based on the results of an interview conducted by the Admissions Committee of the University during the calendar year (this clause was supplemented by the decision of the Council of the Diplomatic Society dated July 31, 2023).

2.3 Master's program

2.3.1 Admission of master students to Abylkas Saginov KTU is performed by placing a state educational order for training personnel in scientific and pedagogical and (or) specialized areas, as well as paying for tuition at the expense of citizens' own funds and the other sources.

2.3.2 Applications for the master's program are submitted to the Admissions Committee of the University through the information system. The application period is from June 1 to July 8 and from October 28 to November 10 of the calendar year (this clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

2.3.3 Comprehensive testing for the master's program is conducted from July 20 to August 10 and from November 18 to December 11 of the calendar year, in computer format at the U-STUDY testing center.

2.3.4 The competition for awarding an educational grant for a master's degree at the expense of the local budget is held until August 25 of the calendar year.

2.3.5 Admission of foreign citizens to study in the educational programs of the master's degree at Abylkas Saginov KTU on a fee-paying basis is performed based on the results of an interview conducted by the Admissions Committee of the University during the calendar year.

2.3.6 Admission to the specialized master's program of persons who have served their compulsory military service on a fee-paying basis within three years after completing their compulsory military service is performed without entrance examinations, based on the results of an interview conducted by the admissions committees of Abylkas Saginov KTU during the calendar year (this clause was supplemented by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated July 31, 2023).

2.4 Doctoral studies

2.4.1 Admission of doctoral students to the University is performed by placing a state educational order for training personnel in scientific and pedagogical and (or) specialized areas, as well as paying for tuition at the expense of citizens' own funds and the other sources.

2.4.2 Applications for doctoral studies are accepted by the Admissions Committee of Abylkas Saginov KTU and accept a package of documents that register them in the information system of the National Testing Center (hereinafter the NTC). The application period is from July 3 to August 3 and from October 25 to November 10 of the calendar year.

2.4.3 Entrance examinations for groups of educational programs in doctoral studies are held from August 4 to August 20 and from November 19 to December 11 of the calendar year.

2.4.4 The interview with the applicant is conducted by the Examination Committee of Abylkas Saginov KTU from August 4 to 15 of the calendar year.

3 Procedure for conducting entrance examinations

3.1 Bachelor's program

3.1.1 To organize and to conduct creative examinations, by decision of Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU or a person acting in his/her capacity, Examination Commissions are formed from June 20 to July 13 of the calendar year (for the period of creative examinations).

The Commission is formed from among the faculty of the University.

3.1.2 Creative examinations are conducted according to groups of educational programs, in accordance with the List of groups of educational programs (Appendix 1).

3.1.3 The programs for conducting creative examinations are developed and approved by Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University before June 20 of the calendar year.

3.1.4 Applications for the creative exam shall be accepted at the University from June 20 to August 3 of the calendar year. (This clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

3.1.5 The schedule of creative exams (the exam format, the date, the time and place, consultations) shall be approved by Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University and shall be communicated to applicants before June 20 of the calendar year (no later than the start of document acceptance).

3.1.6 The creative exam shall be held from July 7 to August 15 of the calendar year. (This clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

The results of the creative exam are recorded in the grade sheet, the Committee minutes in any form and are transferred to the responsible secretary of the admissions committee (his deputy) for the announcement of the results. The Committee minutes are signed by Chairman and all the present members of the Examination Committee.

3.1.7 Based on the results of the creative exam, the applicant is given an extract from the list for admission to Abylkas Saginov KTU or other universities on a fee-paying basis, regardless of the place where the creative exam is taken.

3.2 Bachelor's program. Full-time with a shortened period of training

3.2.1 Persons applying for a group of higher education programs requiring creative training, who have documents on general secondary, technical and vocational or post-secondary education, shall pass two creative exams.

Persons applying for a group of higher education programs requiring creative training in related areas of higher education personnel training shall pass one creative exam.

3.2.2 For graduates of secondary or technical and vocational, post-secondary education organizations applying for a group of higher education programs requiring creative training, points in the history of Kazakhstan, reading literacy (language of instruction) shall be taken into account.

3.2.3 For persons applying for a group of higher education programs requiring creative training in related areas of higher education personnel training, points in a special discipline shall be taken into account.

3.2.4 Creative exams for applicants who have documents on general secondary or technical and vocational, post-secondary education are assessed on a 50-point scale (this clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

3.2.5 The creative exam for applicants in related areas of higher education personnel training is assessed on a 20-point scale.

3.2.6 To organize and conduct entrance examinations for persons with technical and vocational or post-secondary education with the qualification of "mid-level specialist" or "applied bachelor" in related areas of higher education personnel training, and persons with higher education applying on a fee-paying basis, by decision of Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU or the person acting in his/her stead, Examination Committees are created from August 1 to 20 of the calendar year (for the period of the entrance examinations).

3.2.7 Entrance examinations are held for the grades of educational programs, in accordance with the Classifier of Higher and Postgraduate Education Personnel Training.

3.2.8 The programs for conducting entrance examinations are developed in accordance with the UNT disciplines for the corresponding groups of educational programs and approved by Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU before July 1 of the calendar year.

3.3.2.9 Applications for the entrance examination are accepted at Abylkas Saginov KTU from June 20 to August 20 of the calendar year.

3.2.10 The schedule of entrance examinations (the date, the time and the place of the exam) is approved by Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU and communicated to applicants before July 30 of the calendar year (before the start of the entrance examinations).

3.2.11 Entrance examinations are held from August 1 to August 20 of the calendar year.

The results of the entrance examinations are recorded in the grade sheet and the Commission minutes in any form and are submitted for the announcement of the results. The Commission minutes are signed by Chairman and all the members of the Examination Commission present.

3.3 Master's program

3.3.1 Persons who have mastered higher education programs are admitted to the master's program. Persons applying for the master's program take a comprehensive test for groups of educational programs, consisting of a foreign language test, a test for the profile of the group of educational programs, and a test to determine readiness for training.

3.3.2 Persons applying for the master's program indicate in their application one group of educational programs and up to 3 (three) higher and postgraduate education organizations.

3.3.3 Comprehensive testing is conducted from July 20 to August 10 of the calendar year. A certificate is issued based on the results of the comprehensive testing. Retaking the comprehensive testing in the year it is taken is not allowed.

3.3.4 Applicants to a master's degree can at their own request be exempt from the foreign language block if they have an international certificate confirming proficiency in a foreign language in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference (standards) for proficiency in a foreign language, in accordance with the scale of conversion of points, as per Appendices 3-5, in the following languages:

- English: IELTS Academic (International English Language Testing System Academic);
- TOEFL IBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language Internet-based test);
- German: DSH (Deutsche Sprachprüfung fuer den Hochschulzugang), TestDaF-Prüfung;
- French: TFI (Test de Français International™), DELF (Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue française), DALF (Diplôme Approfondi de Langue française), TCF (Test de Connaissance du Français).

3.4 Doctoral studies

3.4.1 Only persons with a Master's degree and at least 9 (nine) months of work experience are admitted to doctoral studies.

3.4.2 Applicants to doctoral studies must provide international certificates confirming proficiency in a foreign language in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Foreign Languages:

English: IELTS Academic (International English Language Testing System), threshold point at least 5.0;

- TOEFL IBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language Internet-based test), threshold point at least 35;

- TOEFL ITP (Test of English as a Foreign Language Institutional Testing Program), threshold point at least 417;

- TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication), threshold point at least 550;

- Duolingo English Test (Duolingo English test), the threshold point is not less than 80;

German:

- Deutsche Sprachprüfung fuer den Hochschulzugang Niveau B1 (DSH, Niveau B1) (DYSIEICH, nivo B1) not lower than level B1;

- TestDaF-Prüfung Niveau B1 (TDF Niveau B1) (TYDIEF, nivo B1) not lower than level B1;

French:

- Test de Français International (Test de France International) (TFI) (TFI) not lower than level B1 in the reading and listening sections;

- Diplome d'Etudes en Langue français (Diplome d'Etudes en Langue français) (DELF) not lower than level B1;
- Diplome Approfondi de Langue français (Diplome Approfondi de Lang Français) (DALF) (DALF) not lower than level B1;
- Test de connaissance du français (Test de connaissance du français) (TCF) (TSF) not below level B1.

Applicants to doctoral studies must provide an official certificate of passing the state language exam (KAZTEST), issued by the NTC, with the exception of foreign citizens, persons who have a certificate of the international standardized test GRE (Graduate Record Examinations), when submitting an application for participation in the entrance exam, must enter the certificate data (information system of the NCT).

The conversion of points of the specified certificate into points of the entrance exam is carried out when submitting an application for participation in the competition for the award of a state educational grant, in accordance with Appendix 5 to the Rules.

The authenticity of the submitted certificates is verified by the Admissions Committee of the University (this clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

3.4.3 Organizing and holding entrance examinations for doctoral studies is performed from August 04 to August 20 of the calendar year.

The composition of the Examination Committees with an indication of their Chairmen is approved by the order of Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University and is sent to the authorized body in the field of education.

By the decision of Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University or a person acting in his/her capacity, Examination Committees are formed to check essays and answers to examination questions and Appeal Committees for groups of educational programs. It is allowed forming one Examination Committee for related areas of personnel training.

3.4.4 Examination Committees for groups of educational programs are formed from among the faculty of the University who have a doctoral or candidate degree, or a doctor of philosophy (PhD) degree in the relevant field. The Examination Committee does not include members of the Appeal Committee. Examination Commissions of the University check the work according to the applicant's individual code and send the results of the review through the information system to the NTC for further publication of the results.

3.4.5 The programs for conducting entrance examinations are developed for the corresponding groups of educational programs and approved by Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University before June 16 of the calendar year with subsequent posting on the website of Abylkas Saginov KTU.

3.4.6 The schedule of entrance examinations (the date, the time and the place of the exam) can be chose by applicants themselves when registering online.

3.4.7 The results of the entrance exam are recorded in the grade sheet on the day of the exam and transferred to the NTC.

4 Enrollment procedure

4.1 Bachelor's program

4.1.1 Students are enrolled in Abylkas Saginov KTU by the University Admissions Committee from August 10 to August 25 of the calendar year by the order of Chairman of the Board, Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU or the person acting in his/her capacity.

Enrollment of holders of an educational grant from the republican budget, as well as tuition fees from citizens' own funds and the other sources, in educational programs of the relevant groups of educational programs is performed on the basis of the decision of the Academic Council of Abylkas Saginov KTU in accordance with the regulatory legal acts of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the specifics of the development of the regional economic sectors.

If necessary, the Admissions Committees of Abylkas Saginov KTU conduct an additional exam for admission to the University.

4.1.2 Enrollment in the University is performed separately for higher education programs and language departments.

Admission to higher education programs for which creative exams are established is performed taking into account the points for these exams.

4.1.3 Citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan admitted on the basis of a state grant sign an agreement to work for at least 3 (three) years in the manner determined by the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

4.1.4. Enrollment of foreign citizens, as well as citizens who have completed military service, is performed in accordance with the academic calendar 5 (five) days before the start of the next academic period (this clause was supplemented by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated July 31, 2023).

4.2 Master's program

4.2.1 Persons shall be admitted to the scientific and pedagogical master's program on a fee-paying basis based on the results of the CT in accordance with the Scale of the 150-point grading system for CT in the master's program with the Kazakh or Russian language of instruction in accordance with Appendix 2: no less than 75 points, with no less than 25 points in a foreign language, in the profile of a group of educational programs: with selecting one correct answer, no less than 7 points, with electing one or more correct answers, no less than 7 points, according to the test to determine readiness for training, no less than 7 points.

Persons shall be admitted to the specialized master's program with the Kazakh or Russian language of instruction on a fee-paying basis based on the results of the CT in accordance with the Scale of the 70-point grading system for comprehensive testing in the specialized master's program with the Kazakh or Russian language of instruction in accordance with Appendix 6 to the Rules; not less than 30 points, with the following for the profile of the group of educational programs: not less than 7 points for the first specialized discipline, not less than 7 points for the second specialized discipline.

Persons with at least five years of experience in a managerial position in accordance with the register of positions of political and administrative civil servants, the register of positions of civil servants in the relevant industries, or at least ten years of experience in the relevant profile of the educational program of the specialized master's degree are enrolled on a paid basis based on the results of an interview conducted by the Admissions Committees of the OHPE (this clause was amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

4.2.2 Persons who have pointed the highest points in the CT are admitted to training under the state educational order on a competitive basis:

1) for a scientific and pedagogical master's degree: at least 75 points, with at least 25 points in a foreign language, according to the profile of a group of educational programs: at least 7 points in the first specialized discipline, at least 7 points in the second specialized discipline, according to the test to determine readiness for training, at least 7 points in accordance with Appendix 2;

2) for a specialized master's degree with Kazakh or Russian as the language of instruction: at least 30 points, with at least 7 points in the profile of a group of educational programs: at least 7 points in the first specialized discipline, at least 7 points in the second specialized discipline, in accordance with Appendix 6;

Persons holding international certificates confirming proficiency in a foreign language IELTS (International English Language Tests System), TOEFL IBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language Inter-net-based test), DSH (Deutsche Sprachprüfung fuer den Hochschulzugang (Deutsche Sprachprüfung), TFI (Test de Français International Connissance du France), and international certificates of passing the standardized test GRE (Graduate Record Examinations), it is necessary to enter the certificate data when submitting an application for participation in the CT in electronic format and in the competition.

The points of the above certificates are transferred after submitting an application for participation in the competition for the award of educational grants at the expense of the republican budget or the local budget or upon enrollment in the OHPE on a paid basis in accordance with

Appendices 2, 3 to the Rules (this clause was supplemented and amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

4.2.3 Enrollment of master students in Abylkas Saginov KTU is carried out by the Admissions Committee of the University before August 28 of the calendar year and before January 10 of the following calendar year by the order of Chairman of the Board, the Rector of Abylkas Saginov KTU or a person acting in his/her capacity.

Enrollment of foreign citizens, as well as citizens who have served in the military, is performed in accordance with the academic calendar 5 (five) days before the start of the next academic period (this clause was supplemented by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated July 31, 2023).

4.3 Doctoral studies

4.3.1 Persons are admitted to doctoral studies on the basis of an international certificate confirming proficiency in a foreign language in accordance with the common European competencies (standards) for proficiency in a foreign language and based on the results of the entrance examination in the profile of the group of educational programs of doctoral studies and having pointed at least 75 points out of a possible 100 points.

Persons are admitted to doctoral studies with the Kazakh or Russian language for training under the state educational order on a competitive basis based on the results of entrance examinations in accordance with the Scale of the 100-point grading system for admission to doctoral studies with the Kazakh or Russian language of instruction in accordance with Appendix 7 to the Rules (this clause was supplemented and amended by the decision of the Board of Directors of the University dated June 25, 2024).

4.3.2 Persons who have acquired at least 75 points in the entrance exam are admitted to doctoral studies under the state educational order on a competitive basis.

4.3.3 Enrollment of doctoral students in Abylkas Saginov KTU is performed by the University Admissions Committee before August 28 of the calendar year and before January 10 of the following calendar year by the order of Chairman of the Board, Rector of the University or a person acting in his/her capacity.

5 Final provisions

5.1. The responsible secretary of the Admissions Committee shall monitor implementing the Admission Rules to the Abylkas Saginov KTU.

5.2. These Admission Rules to Abylkas Saginov KTU shall be communicated to the heads of all the structural divisions of the University for mandatory use in their work.
