Rules for the appointment of the Alimkhan Ermekov scholarship

1. These Rules define the procedure for awarding the Alimkhan Yermekov Scholarship, established on the basis of the resolution of the International Scientific and Practical Online Conference "Alimkhan Yermekov and the Formation of Kazakh Statehood" with the aim of perpetuating the memory of the victims of political repression, including those who demonstrated heroism in the struggle for freedom, independence, and territorial integrity of Kazakhstan.

2. The scholarship is awarded to students in years 2-4(5) of full-time education at the KarTU named after Abylkas Saginov, studying both on the basis of a state educational grant and on a fee-paying basis, who have significant achievements in socio-political, academic (GPA of at least 3.0) and scientific research activities.

3. The scholarship is awarded by order of the Chairman of the Board – Rector of KarTU named after Abylkas Saginov based on the decision of the Alimkhan Ermekov Scholarship Appointment Commission and the Academic Council.

4. Scholarship applicants submit a portfolio of personal achievements to the Commission. The portfolio must include original copies of the faculty council's recommendation, transcripts for the entire period of study, as well as copies of diplomas, letters of appreciation, certificates, scientific publications, and other documents confirming the applicants' achievements.

5. The scholarship is awarded for an academic semester.

6. Number of scholarships – 1.

7. The amount of the scholarship corresponds to the amount of the state scholarship in effect at the time of appointment, established for students studying under the state educational order. Стипендия может неоднократно присуждаться одному и тому же лицу.

8. Payment of scholarships is made during the academic semester monthly from the University's extra-budgetary funds.
